Do not call or go to the county courthouse before first reading these instructions. Take this notice with you if you consult an attorney.

You must respond to your citation within 30 days by pleading guilty and paying the fine or by pleading not guilty. If you pay your fine at the court, there may be additional court costs and possibly a higher fine. Failure to respond on time could result in a fine of up to \$1000 and one year in jail and could also lead to suspension of your driver's license and a warrant for your arrest.

To Plead Guilty and Pay Your Fine: Sign back of citation and return it along with a check or money order (in US dollars) for full amount due payable to Fine Collection Center. Write citation number and daytime phone number on front of check/money order and mail to address at top of page. See back of this sheet and the other sheet in your envelope for fine amounts and more information. **You may pay using MasterCard or Visa by phone at 877-866-3926 or on the Internet at www.mofcc.com.** There is a \$4 surcharge for Internet/phone payments.

To Plead Not Guilty: Complete information below and mail to Fine Collection Center or fax to 573-522-8504. Your citation will be sent to the county prosecutor. The court will notify you of your court date by mail.

IMPORTANT: Read the other instruction sheets first. If you determine the exact amount due at www.mofcc.com or by calling 877-866-3926, then you can ignore this side.

1. If your citation states the offense occurred in a "travel safe zone" or in an "active emergency zone," you must go on the Internet to www.mofcc.com or call 877-866-3926 to determine the amount due. Do not use this fine schedule.

2. Seat Belt Violations: If the "seat belt violation" block is completed (see lower left of your citation above officer's signature) you owe an extra \$10 for seat belt in addition to the amount owed for your primary offense.

3. Construction/Work Zone Offenses: If your citation states the offense occurred in a construction/work zone, **add \$35 to the amount due** on the fine schedule except for speeding offenses, which show this extra \$35 on this fine schedule handout.

4. If your speeding Charge Code starts with 304.130-002, 304.130-003, 304.130-004 or 304.130-005, deduct \$4 from the total owed on this fine schedule handout.

5. Additional Court Costs For Certain Counties: You must add the amount below to the fine amount listed for your offense (except \$10 seat belt, \$10 no lights, & \$25 motorcycle helmet violations) if you received your citation in the following counties.
