Division	Case Type	New Filings/Pending Cases
All	All probate, excluding mental health cases	New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases, excluding wills, bonds, and receipts
All	All criminal cases including municipal trial de novo cases, traffic, infractions, watercraft and conservation cases	Subsequent pleadings in all cases
All	All domestic relations case types, including paternity, except for orders of protection	New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases
All	All associate civil cases	New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases
All	Circuit civil cases	New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases

The clerk's office shall notify all members of the county bar of this order as well as any other persons the clerk's office deems appropriate and shall assist those making such filings. The clerk's office also shall report any problems to the OSCA Help Desk.
